WHAT IS CBD?

CBD is also known as cannabidiol and derives from the hemp plant. Hemp is a cousin of marijuana but without the psychoactive effects of THC.

Hemp-derived CBD contains less than 0.3 percent THC, making it impossible to get addicted or high from it. Instead, hemp is rich in many other beneficial cannabinoids that work together with the endocannabinoid system.

HOW DOES CBD WORK?

CBD acts on animals similarly to how it works on you.

Humans, cats, and dogs all have cannabinoid (CBD) receptors in their nervous systems.

This part of the nervous system is called the endocannabinoid system, and it works to maintain balance in the body.

The long list of benefits includes supporting a normal inflammatory response, optimal body function, a healthy immune system response, promoting calmness and relaxation, and digestive support, just to name a few.

HOW MUCH TO GIVE MY PET?

When it comes to dosing, make sure to check out the label on the product.

CBD oils, tinctures, and chews all vary in their potency per dose. Depending on the manufacturer, product, or brand, the dosage for one type of CBD oil may differ vastly from another.

The amount to give depends on the pet's weight.

With oil, you can add a few drops to the treat or food. If your furry friend is tolerant, you can open its mouth and squirt it on the tongue.

Every animal varies, which means some animals may react to CBD products differently.

Some pet parents may notice a calmer demeanor quite quickly, but it usually takes about an hour to take full effect.

If an hour passes and the pet is not seemingly calmer, consider giving more CBD. Some pets may require more or less CBD for it to work for them.





IS IT SAFE?

There are no known overdoses on a full spectrum CBD product, meaning you can always give more CBD if needed.

Start with the recommended dose and if that doesn't work, try offering more.

CBD usage in pets does not cause side effects, just side benefits.

As long as the CBD comes from a trusted source, you can stay calm.

WHAT DOES A THIRD-PARTY LAB REPORT INCLUDE?
